

# Eid Takbeer

A simple, beautiful takbeer sheet for Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha, with Arabic text, transliteration, translation, and the most important recitation timings.

## COMMON TAKBEER FORMAT

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَاللَّهُ  
أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ وَلِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ

**Transliteration:** Allahu akbar, Allahu akbar, La ilaha illallah, Wallahu akbar, Allahu akbar wa lillahil hamd.

**Translation:** Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest, there is no god but Allah. Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest, and to Allah belongs all praise.

### How to Recite

- Men may recite it aloud in mosques, homes, and public spaces.
- Women may recite it softly.
- It can be recited while walking, driving, sitting, or waiting for prayer.

### Quick Reminder

- This takbeer is a highly emphasized Sunnah.
- It is not only for Hajj pilgrims.
- It is a remembrance of Allah's greatness during Eid days.

# Core Timing Guide

The exact takbeer wording has more than one acceptable form in the scholarly tradition, but the shorter common wording below is widely used and easy to memorize. These are the main timing rules from the content you provided.

## Eid al-Fitr

Recite from **sunset on the last day of Ramadan** until the Imam begins the Eid prayer.

## Eid al-Adha / Takbeer al-Tashreeq

Recite from **Fajr on the 9th of Dhul Hijjah** until **'Asr on the 13th of Dhul Hijjah**. It is especially recited after each obligatory prayer.

## EID PRAYER TAKBEER GUIDE

1

### First Rak'ah

After the opening takbeer and opening supplication, say **7 takbeers** in total for the first rak'ah according to the format you provided, before Surah al-Fatihah.

2

### Second Rak'ah

When rising for the second rak'ah, say **5 takbeers** before the recitation.

### Action

Raise the hands for each takbeer, following the imam in congregation.

4

### After Fard Prayer

For Takbeer al-Tashreeq in Eid al-Adha, recite it **immediately after the tasleem** of each obligatory prayer.

## Common Mistakes to Avoid

- Forgetting the takbeer after obligatory prayers during the days of Tashreeq.
- Assuming it is only for people performing Hajj.
- Mixing up the general Eid takbeer with the after-prayer Takbeer al-Tashreeq.
